So go on. We'll take care of the chores, while you make yourself at home.





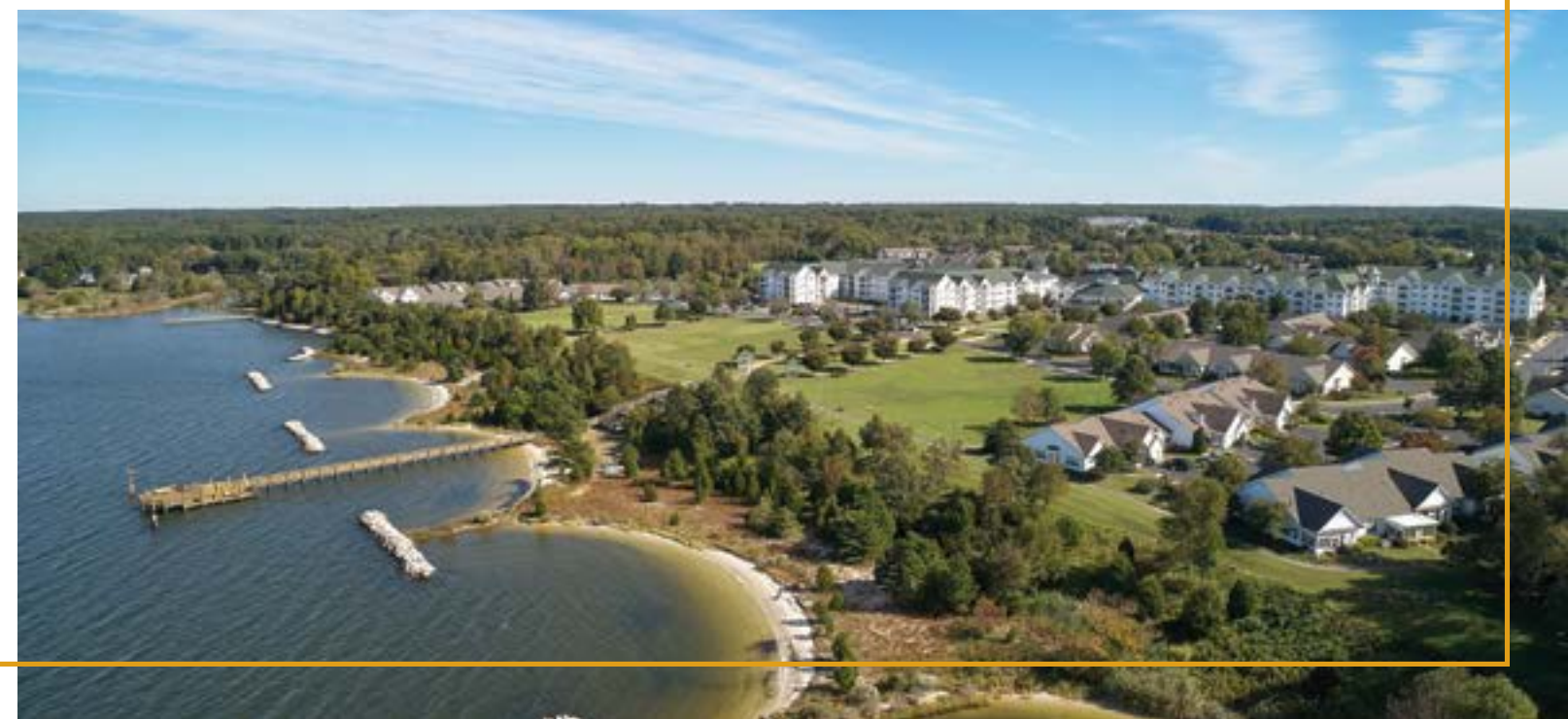
Content and confident, you're leaving ordinary life behind

Well-being informs everything we do – from classes focusing on flexibility, balance, and strength; to our brain health program and coach; social events and volunteer opportunities; to unique resident clubs, cultural events, and lifelong learning classes; and so much more.

We have more than 50 resident-led clubs like the Go Green Committee, Computer and Art clubs, and The Asbury Solomons Players theater group. And, there is always room for more!

In 2023, Northwestern University and Mather Institute completed their 5-year Age Well Study of more than 8,000 residents of continuing care retirement communities. Overall, residents reported greater emotional, social, physical, and intellectual wellness than their peers, and 70% reported that moving “greatly improved” their social wellness.

Glossary | Become familiar with the terminology of senior living.

Accreditation. A seal of approval given by an autonomous organization that demonstrates key indicators they have determined are important to quality, Mission, and strong operations. Asbury holds EAGLE accreditation through the United Methodist Association of Health & Welfare Ministries, which requires rigorous documentation of criteria and a peer review process. Assisted Living. A special combination of housing, personalized supportive services and health care designed to meet the needs — both scheduled and unscheduled — of those who need help with daily living activities.

CCRC or Continuing Care Retirement Community. A senior living community that provides a written agreement or long-term contract between the resident and the community, providing for a continuum of housing, services and health care, all on one campus or site. Typically, a CCRC includes independent living (or residential living), assisted living and a skilled nursing care center.

Continuum of Care. A reference to the seamlessly integrated levels of care in the progression through independent or residential living to assisted living and skilled nursing.

Entrance Fee. The single, upfront payment that provides for residency in a CCRC.

Independent Living. See Residential Living.

MSF or Monthly Service Fee. Determined by the size of the residence, this fee covers common costs associated with residency, including campus amenities, maintenance, utilities and emergency response.

Not-for-Profit. A status of ownership where governance is through a Board of Trustees. Board members ensure a not-for-profit CCRC's approach to serving seniors meets local needs, maintains financial strength, and aligns with the organization's Mission. Not-for-profit communities turn surplus income back into community improvements and service expansions and operate according to a Mission of service to residents, its key stakeholders.

Residential Living. A healthy, active, engaged lifestyle for independent seniors.

Second-Person Fee. With fee structures built around single occupancy of a residence, two residents can expect a second-person fee to cover the additional costs associated with living here.

Services & Amenities. Lists of what the community provides that enhance the community living experience.

Skilled Nursing. 24-hour care for residents with acute needs. Residents usually rely on assistance for most or all daily living activities. Regular medical supervision and rehabilitation therapies are provided.

Entrance Fee Plans

Asbury Solomons is a mission-focused, not-for-profit Continuing Care Retirement Community. Your one-time entrance fee - paid when you sign a contract for residency at Asbury Solomons - guarantees your residence and access to services for your lifetime. No matter which Entrance Fee Plan you choose, you always have the security of knowing that assisted living, skilled care, and an array of home care services are available to you as part of Asbury's full continuum of care. Choose the Entrance Fee Plan That's Right for You

Based on years of experience, we recognize that people prefer having choices to satisfy different financial objectives. With this in mind, Asbury Solomons offers a variety of contract options:

80% REFUNDABLE PLAN: With this plan, you receive a 80% refund of your entrance fee, payable to you or your estate at the time you are no longer a resident at Asbury Solomons. Again, the advantage of a refundable Entrance Fee Plan is that it allows you to predict the amount of your refund and offers value through preserving your assets for the future.

STANDARD PLAN: Entrance fees for this plan are partially refundable during the first 50 months you live at Asbury Solomons. The refund decreases by 2% each month of residency, until after 50 months, there is no refund. Because this plan offers the lowest entrance fees, it is the most affordable way to enjoy the Asbury Solomons lifestyle.

**Generally, the entrance fee is refunded when your residence is re-occupied by a resident who pays a new entrance fee. Specific terms regarding the refund of entrance fees are contained in the Residency Agreement.*

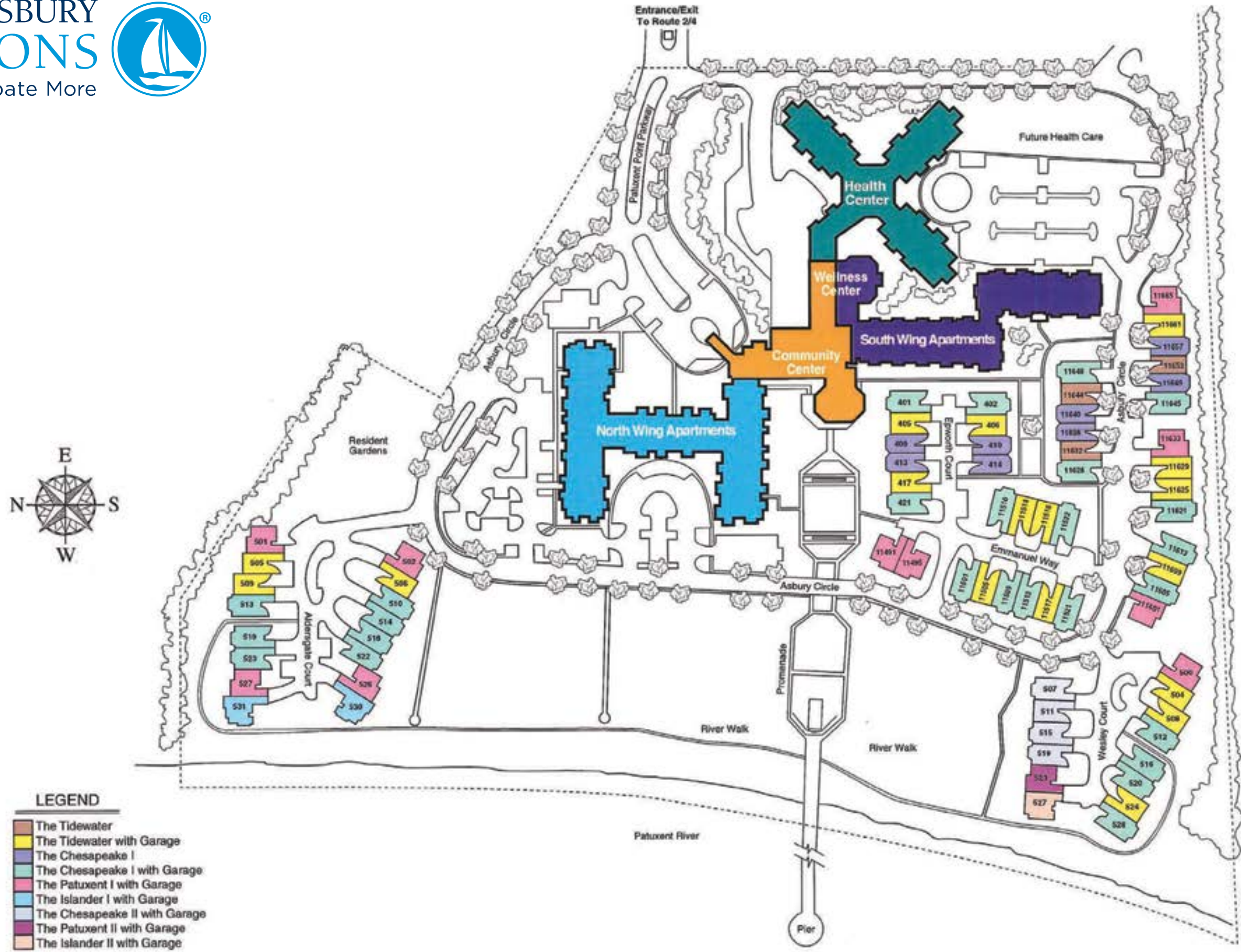
Commitment to Excellence and Innovation
